

2025 Golf Season is Fast Approaching!!

Happy Spring, Ladies!

Golf season is just around the corner and we should begin thinking of our upcoming league play. Our first day of league play will be June 3, 2025, with a putting clinic at 9:15 a.m., 10:00 a.m. shotgun start, followed by lunch and an informational meeting. This will be a 4-person Shamble. Please go online (www.troutlakegolf.com) to sign up by Saturday, May 31, 5:00 p.m.

The late season start is due to the renovation project. In 2026, we will again begin league play in May.

The membership dues will remain at \$40.00. The dues cover a hole sponsorship for "Let's Tee Off Against Breast Cancer", food for lunches, guest day gifts, table decorations, and sunshine fund. The membership form is posted on the website and dues must be received no later than June 17. Our entry fee per week will continue to be \$3.00 per person.

Please sign up for weekly play by 5:00 p.m. Saturday prior to league play by going to www.troutlakegolf.com and click on Ladies League. Our system does allow you to sign up for all events at once, but please sign up for only one week at a time. If you sign up and are unable to play, please call the pro shop as soon as possible to cancel. Tee times will be emailed to you sometime Sunday afternoon or Monday morning. We are asking you to please limit your special requests for tee times. We understand there are situations with appointments, guests, or other emergencies, but please do not consistently ask for early or late tee times. It becomes very difficult for the pro shop to assign tee times.

We will be offering six 18-hole option days. When signing up for these dates, please make sure that you post in the comment section that you are playing 18 holes. Nine of these holes will be played for the game of the day.

Member/guest day will be June 24 with a 10:00 shotgun start. This will be a 2-person scramble with lunch to be served after play. Remember to invite a friend to join us to see how fun we are. You do not have to bring a guest to

participate that day. Each guest will receive a gift from the league as a thank you for joining us. If you are bringing a guest, please type your guest's name in the comments section when signing up.

The 16th annual "Let's Tee Off Against Breast Cancer" scramble will be Thursday, June 19, 2025. Teams are restricted to the first 36 **PAID** teams. Payment is due with registration to reserve your spot. All payments go to the Howard Young Foundation. Because of the late start this season, we are going to extend play into September with our end-of-the year banquet scheduled for September 23.

We have scheduled four happy hours with snacks and discounted drinks. For 2025, there will be a snack sign-up sheet on the bulletin board in the hallway asking for 10 ladies to bring in an appetizer. This is a great time to get to know your fellow lady golfers.

As a courtesy to Scott as well as all of our lady golfers, please arrive a minimum of 30 minutes prior to your tee time.
